Library Board of Trustees nominating petitions are available for the May 2017 election. Nominating petitions are currently available for individuals interested in serving on the Schuylerville Public Library Board of Trustees. Three seats will be up for election on May 16 this year, the same day as the school budget vote.

Those interested in running for this important role in our community may pick up a petition from the Library circulation desk at 52 Ferry Street in the Village of Schuylerville. In order for a candidate to appear on the ballot, they must return their petition with the signatures of 25 qualified district voters by 4pm on April 17 to the School District Clerk office District Clerk, Schuylerville Central School District, 14 Spring Street, Schuylerville, NY 12871.

Candidates must be at least 18 years old, qualified voters in the school district, and have resided in the district continuously for at least one year before the election. We recommend obtaining a few extra signatures in case there is a discrepancy of any kind.

Board members serve a three-year volunteer term. Two of the terms of the Board members elected this year will begin on July 1, 2017 and expire on June 30, 2020 and the candidate with the third highest votes cast in his/her favor shall fill the balance of a term ending in 2018, created by the resignation of a former Trustee.
