The summer of 2015 saw record numbers of youth take part in Schuylerville Public Library's summer reading program. Over 3765 children attended 68 programs in June, July and August at the library. Children and teens logged over 19,566 minutes of reading this summer.

"This program has been a wonderful success and it reinforces the lessons students learn during the school year," said Board President Amy Carpenter. "I am very pleased the programs offered by the library staff were so successful."

Schuylerville library also had the honor of hosting two New York State elected officials. Senator Kathy Marchione and Assemblywoman Carrie Woerner each led very well attended story hours for children in August.

"The theme of summer reading was "Every Hero Has a Story," celebrating many types of heroes" explained Library Director Caitlin Johnson. "Superhero capes were a big hit with children of all ages." Programs offered by the library included Lego Club, Dazzle Dogs, Princess Party, Kathy Ceceri's Robot Heroes, Recycled Craft Club, Ice Cream kick-off party, and music events by River Jack Z and Howl at the Moon.
