

REMOTE STORAGE

The Cloud:

- File hosting services like:
   Dropbox, Google docs
   or through most emails
- Movies you purchase with digital copies may have storage options through cloud services like Ultra Violet

#### DON'T STORE IT AT ALL

When you purchase digital materials from companies like Amazon and Nook, You are purchasing the digital rights (DRM) for that item. This gives you the right to re-download that item as many times as you want onto as many devices as you want...

#### • DON'T STORE IT AT ALL

As long as that company still provides the service, still exists, you maintain a membership, pay fees, or some other reason that isn't quite clear to you...

Read the fine print.

You can buy digital media DRM free, but you are responsible for saving storing and transferring files, and you may a limited window in which to acquire it.

#### FILE TRANSFER OR RETRIEVAL

- Share
  - Send via email, message, facebook…
  - Wi-fi network
- Hard line
  - Physically connect 2 devices
  - Some devices can only use certain file types but can still store them

### FILE TRANSFER OR RETRIEVAL

- Removable device storage
  - Your stick, cards, and drives...
- Remote retrieval
  - The cloud
- Download or stream



## KEEPING ORGANIZED

- WHAT (NOT) TO SAVE
  - Is it the original, a duplication, or alteration?
  - Is it replicable/replaceable?
  - Do you or will you really need it?
    - Archive/posterity




